Re: Registration for 2012 Season

In keeping with the spirit and intent of previous year's successful seasons, the Parks and Recreation 10U and 12U softball programs are formatted to offer another option for those not wishing to participate in other local "traveling" softball programs.

So that you are fully aware and informed about what the Parks and Recreation 10U and 12U programs entail, here are some specific details:

- Girls who are 9 or 10 years old on December 31, 2011 are eligible to play 10U; girls who are 11 or 12 years old on December 31, 2011 are eligible to play 12U.
- Teams will participate in the Saunders/Butler League. Teams participating in the league are from Butler or Saunders County.
- The league is "competitive" however the program is structured so that skill development and having an enjoyable experience remain a priority.
- Children will play equal time during regular season however during the league tournament a "play to win" approach will be used.
- Teams will play 10+ games. This includes regular season games plus the league tournament. **The league tournament is typically the only weekend games scheduled.** All other regular season games will be played on weeknights.
- Teams will play approximately half their games in Wahoo with remaining games held in the other Butler or Saunders County communities.
- Practices will begin in late April with games typically starting the week before Memorial Day weekend. The season will conclude by late June or early July.
- Registration for the program is on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - We will sponsor one team for 12U softball.
 - For the 10U program...once we receive sufficient registrations to form one team, any subsequent registrations will be held until enough are received to form another team. In previous years we have had enough players register to be able to form 2 or 3 teams.
- If we are able to have more than one team, a player evaluation may be held in late winter or early spring so that teams may be formed as evenly as possible.
- Please Note: The Butler/Saunders league is not organized by Wahoo Parks and Rec. If for whatever reason we feel the league is lacking proper organization and/or amount of teams, we will explore other avenues that may include playing independent of any league or play in either the Todd Valley or Logan Valley League. REGISTRATION PERIOD: Now through January 31st. Register early to avoid a \$10 late fee and the probability of teams being full!

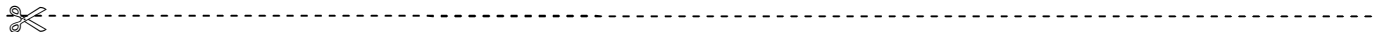

AGES: For 10U: Girls ages 9 & 10. For 12U: Girls ages 11 & 12. Age is determined by the player's age as of December 31, 2011.

PROGRAM FORMAT: Teams will play in the Saunders/Butler League. Teams will play approximately 10-12 games with half of those games played outside of Wahoo and most being held on weeknights. Teams will also participate in the league tournament. Games will begin in late May. Practice will begin in late April. All home games will be played at Hackberry Park. League is competitive and is not organized by Wahoo Parks and Rec.

MISCELLANEOUS: Participants and their parents/guardians should be aware that there is a risk of injury during participation in Wahoo youth sports programs due to the inherent nature of the activities. Individuals participate in Parks and Recreation programs at their own risk.
