T-BALL LEAGUE RULES

1. No leading off.
2. No base stealing.
3. A player will receive five swings to hit the ball. If the ball does not pass the 20 ft. foul line by the fifth swing, the player will advance to first base.
4. First team listed is the “visiting” team. Game scores and league standings will not be maintained.
5. An inning will consist of each team batting all of their players. The “visiting” team will bat first. After all players have batted, the team will switch to playing defense regardless of how many outs there are.
6. If the defense makes an out, the batter or runner must leave the playing field.
7. Defensively, all players play in the field.
8. Outfielders must be on the grass.
9. Runners can not advance on overthrows.
10. Each game will consist of four innings or a one hour time limit, whichever comes first. No new inning will start after the 50-minute mark. If the inning is not finished and the game is nearing the one hour time limit, “last batter” will be called by the coaches.
11. The coach may pitch the last two games of the season (note coach-pitch league rules).
12. No metal spikes.
