

YOUTH BASKETBALL



PROGRAM PHILOSOPHY: The mission of all Wahoo Parks and Recreation youth sports programs is to promote a fun, yet challenging environment in which participants are introduced to and taught the basics of a given sport. The program is strictly recreational in nature and emphasizes equal opportunity for involvement and participation.

REGISTRATION PERIOD: Registration begins September 22nd for all grade levels. The registration deadline for 1/2 and 5/6 grade is October 13th. The registration deadline for 3/4 grade is October 27th. All registrations after the deadline will incur a \$10 late fee. Late registrations will be accepted up to a week after the deadline.

PROGRAM FORMAT:

1st & 2nd Grade: A clinic is offered at this level to introduce participants to the fundamental motor skills necessary for participation in the sport. The clinic will consist of five, 45-minute sessions held on the following Sunday afternoons: 10/26, 11/2, 11/9, 11/16, and 11/23. The girl's clinic will start at 3pm and the boy's clinic will start at 4pm. All sessions will be held at Wahoo Elementary.

3rd & 4th Grade: All league games will be played on Saturdays. Teams will play a round robin schedule and are guaranteed a minimum of six games. League play is tentatively scheduled to begin on Saturday, January 10th with games scheduled for the Civic Center. Game times normally are between 8am and 2pm. Games are officiated but game scores will not be kept.

5th & 6th Grade: All league games will be played on Saturdays. Teams will play a round robin schedule and are guaranteed a minimum of six games. League play will begin on Saturday, December 6th with games scheduled for the Civic Center. Game times normally are between 8am and 2pm. Games are officiated and game scores will be kept.

Realizing that my child is playing for fun, recreation, and personal betterment, I hereby for myself and for my child, our heirs, personal representatives and assigns, waive and release any and all claim for injuries or damages of any kind of nature which either I or my child may have against the City of Wahoo, any manager, coach, instructor, umpire, referee or assistant thereto, anyone who prepares a playing field for any practice session or any formal game, chaperones, sponsors or anyone who organizes or causes this program to operate, their agents, representatives and assigns as a result of any practice session or game or any participating in said sports program and indemnify the City of Wahoo, and all parties named herein against such claim or damages arising from such claims. We hereby agree that coaches, managers, umpires, referees, their assistants or anyone who prepares a playing field shall not be liable for the injury or death of my child as a participant in said Wahoo parks and Recreation programs which results from the negligence of any of the above listed individuals. I understand that the City of Wahoo assumes no legal or financial responsibility in case of accident or injury and I assume full responsibility for my child's medical expenses and waive all rights or causes of action, which my child or I may have against the City of Wahoo and each of the persons named herein.

EQUIPMENT: All players must wear tennis shoes with non-marking soles. Basketballs will be provided.

UNIFORMS (3rd-6th grade): Youth participating in Wahoo Parks and Recreation youth sports are required to have and wear two uniform t-shirts, one red and one blue. The playing schedule dictates which color shirt to wear for each game. These shirts are used for all youth sport programs and are available in a variety of youth and adult sizes and can be purchased at the Civic Center for \$6 each.

ROSTERS: Team rosters for 5/6 grade teams are formed via coach's draft while 3/4 grade team rosters are formed via random selection. Parents may request their son/daughter be placed on a team with one other child for carpooling purposes only (not all requests may be honored). This information needs to be indicated on the registration form. Once teams are formed, coaches are responsible for contacting players on their rosters to set up practices and distribute information.

COACHES: Wahoo Parks and Recreation utilizes volunteer coaches for all youth sport programs. All head coaches are required to attend a coaches meeting where philosophies and coaching ideas are shared.

SCHEDULES: Playing schedules will be available after the coach's meeting on our website.

MISCELLANEOUS: Participants and their parents/guardians should be aware that there is a risk of injury during participation in Wahoo Parks and Recreation youth sports due to the inherent nature of the activities. Individuals participate in Parks and Recreation youth sports at their own risk.
